Top Coast home decided

A striking home in Greymouth has been named this year's top West Coast property, winning the Supreme Award in the West Coast Registered Master Builders PlaceMakers 2011 House of the Year and RMB Commercial Project Awards held at Shantytown on Saturday night.

Tony Wilkins Builder Limited in Greymouth took out the PlaceMakers Supreme Award for the House of the Year for the stunning build of a home in the New Homes \$600,000 — \$1 million category. The home also won the Gib Living Award.
